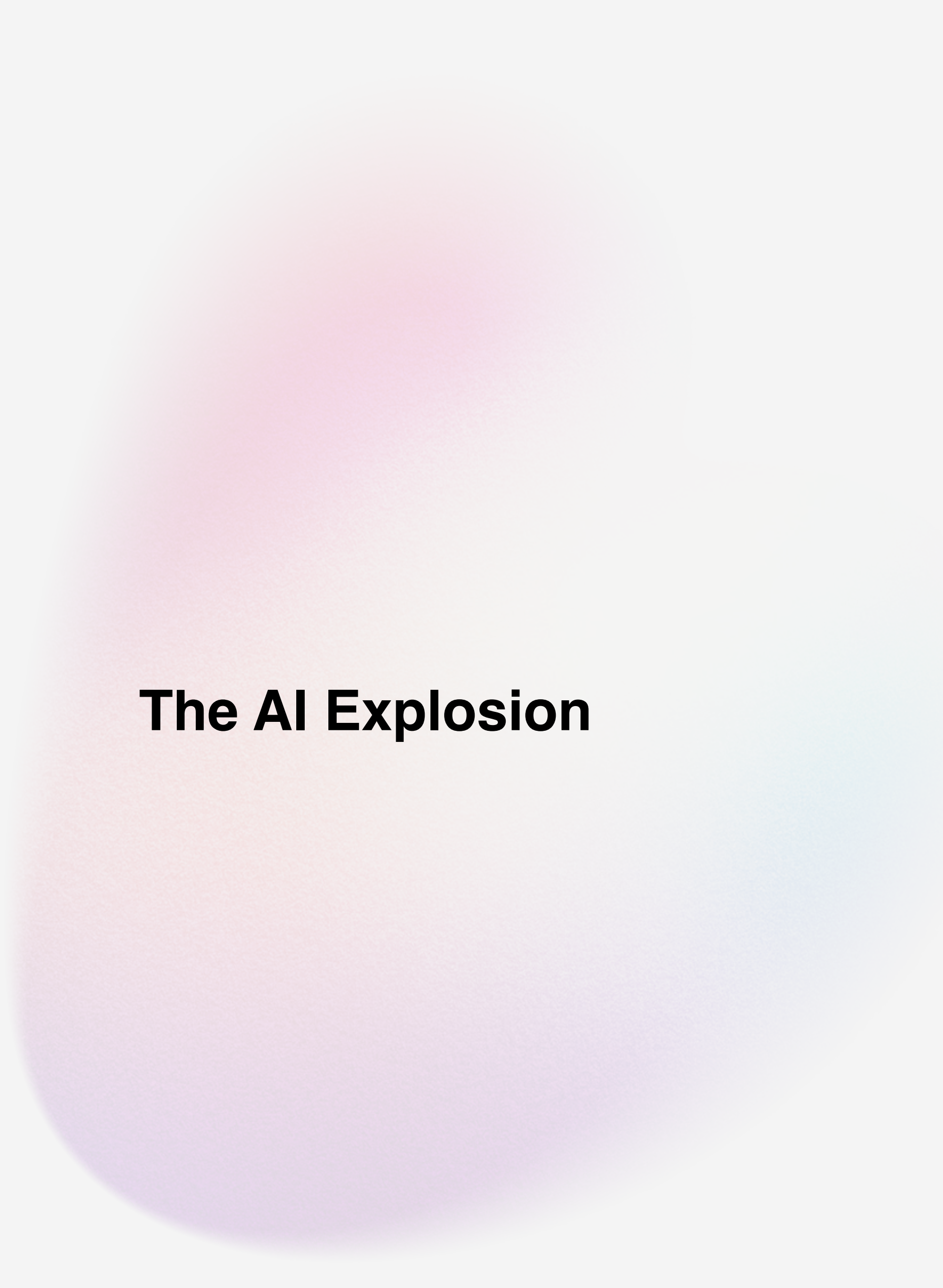
The AI explosion

How many are currently being released daily in 2026?



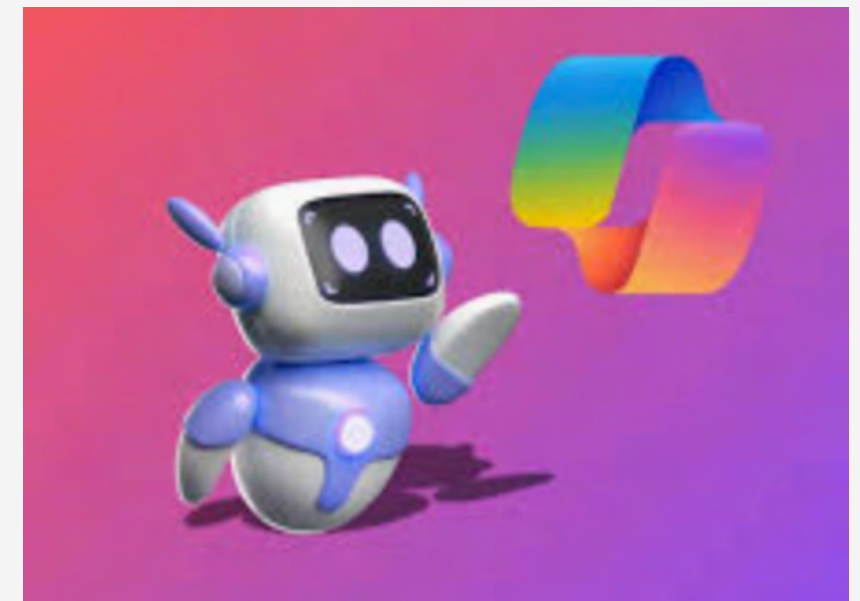

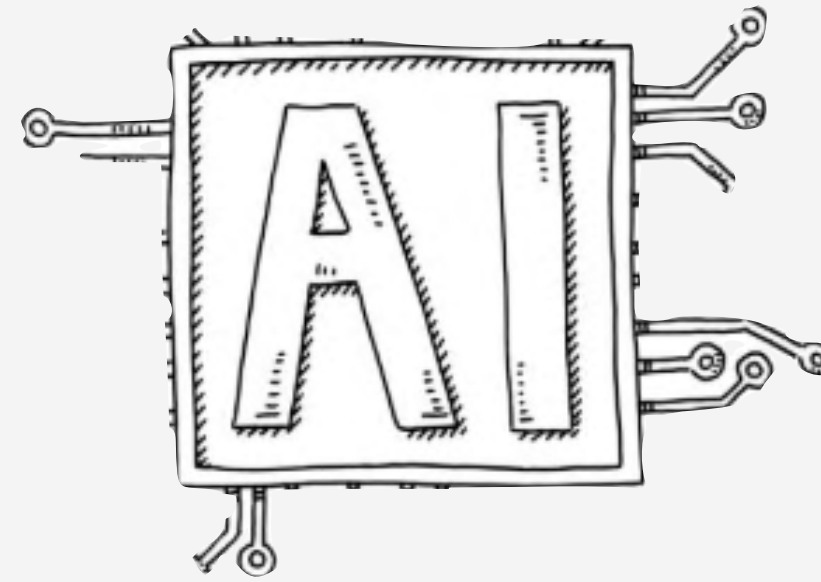

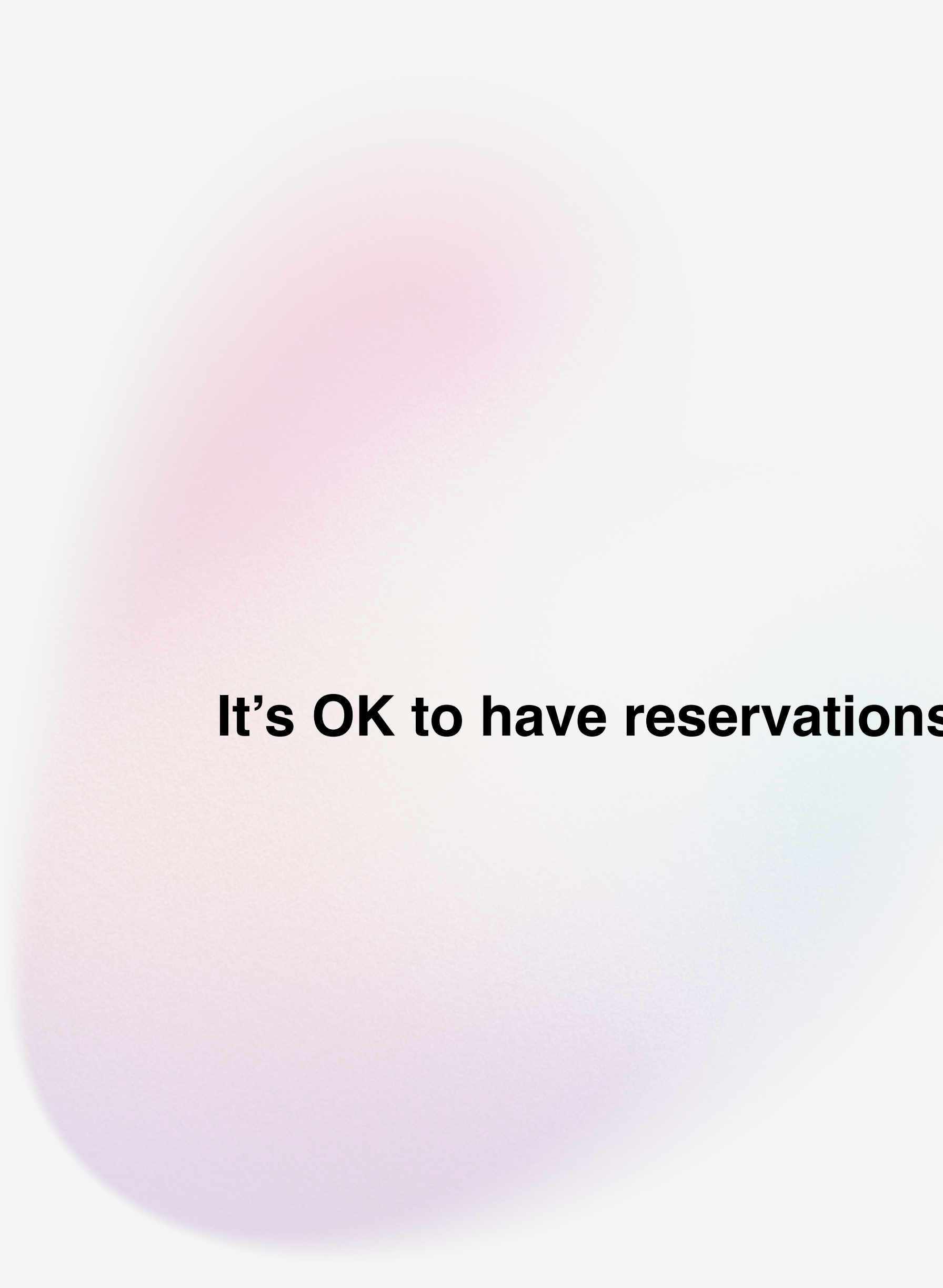

It's OK to have reservations

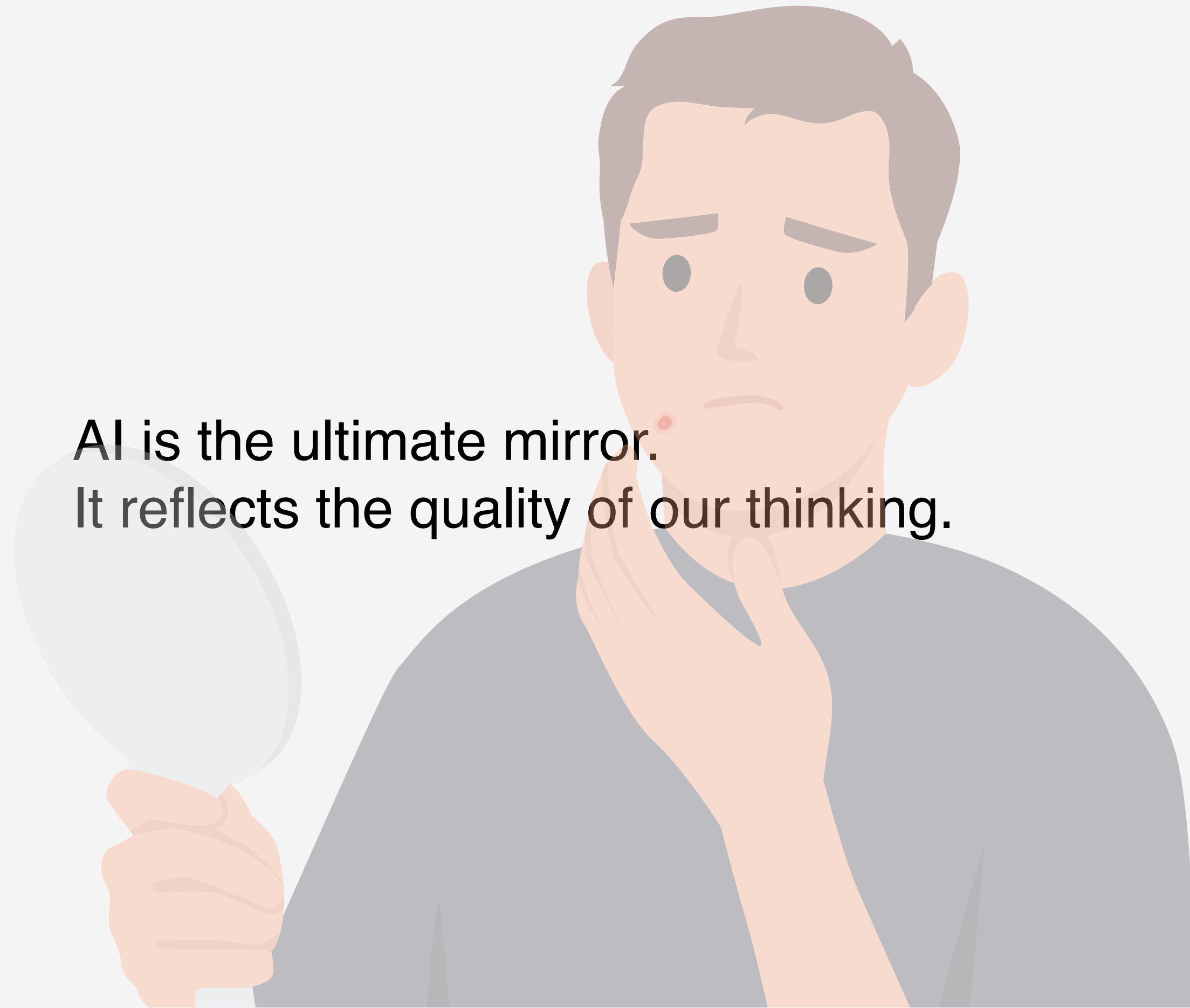
That means you're Human.

Our level of comfort

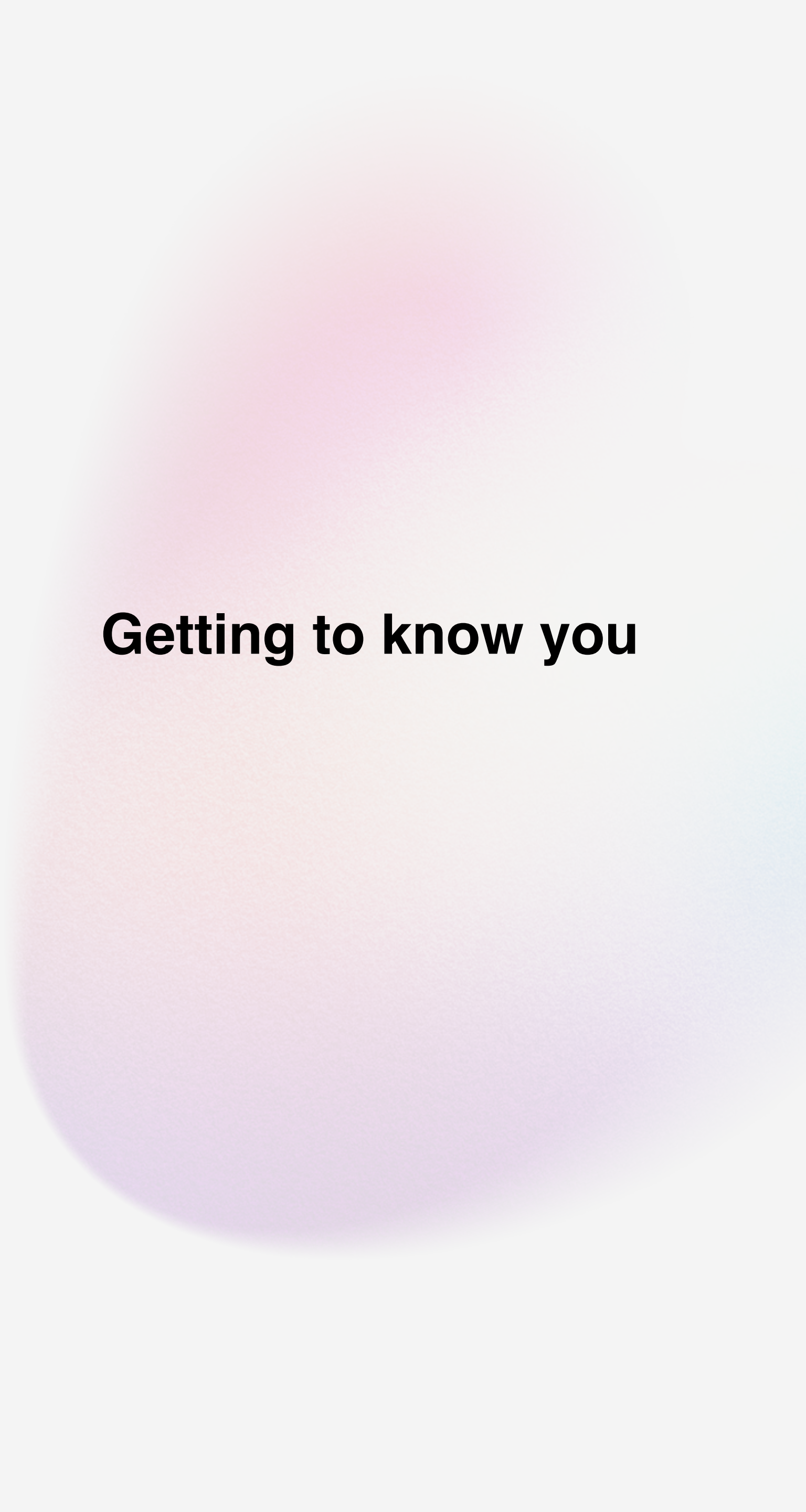
Frustration and Impatience

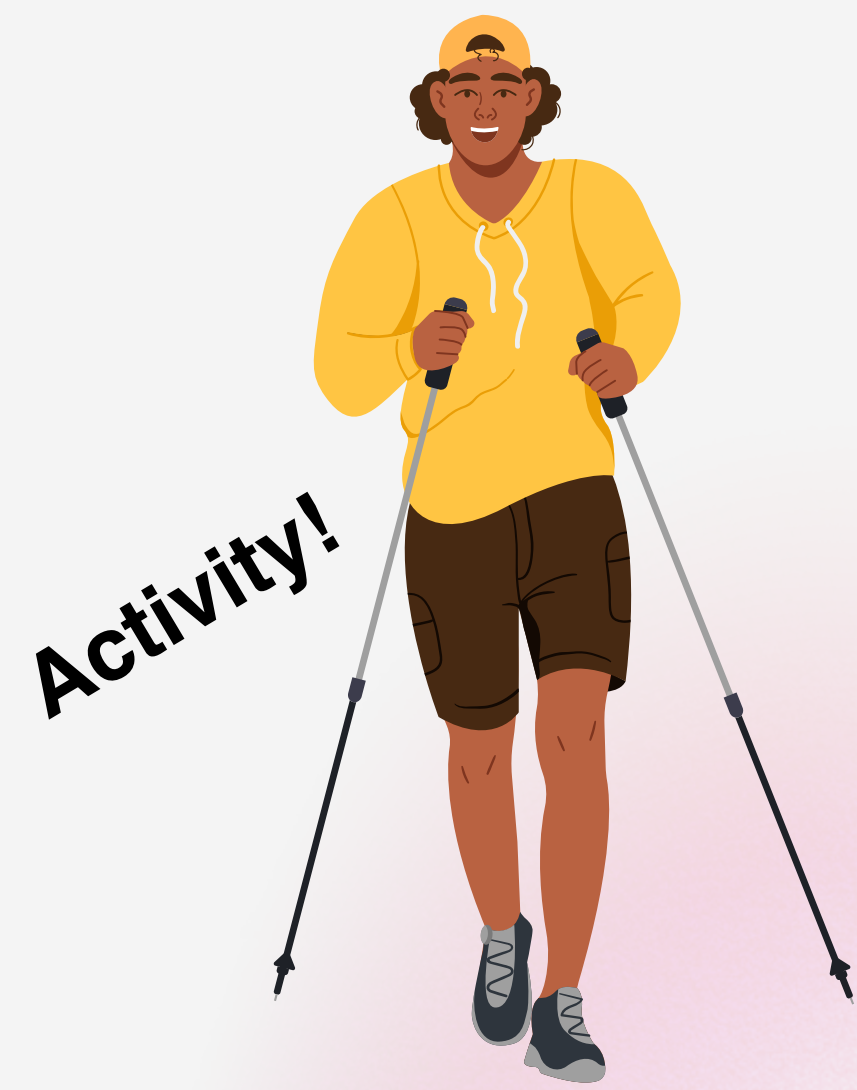


Getting to know you

There are two simple steps people forget when working with an AI:

It doesn't know who you are
And it doesn't know what you need

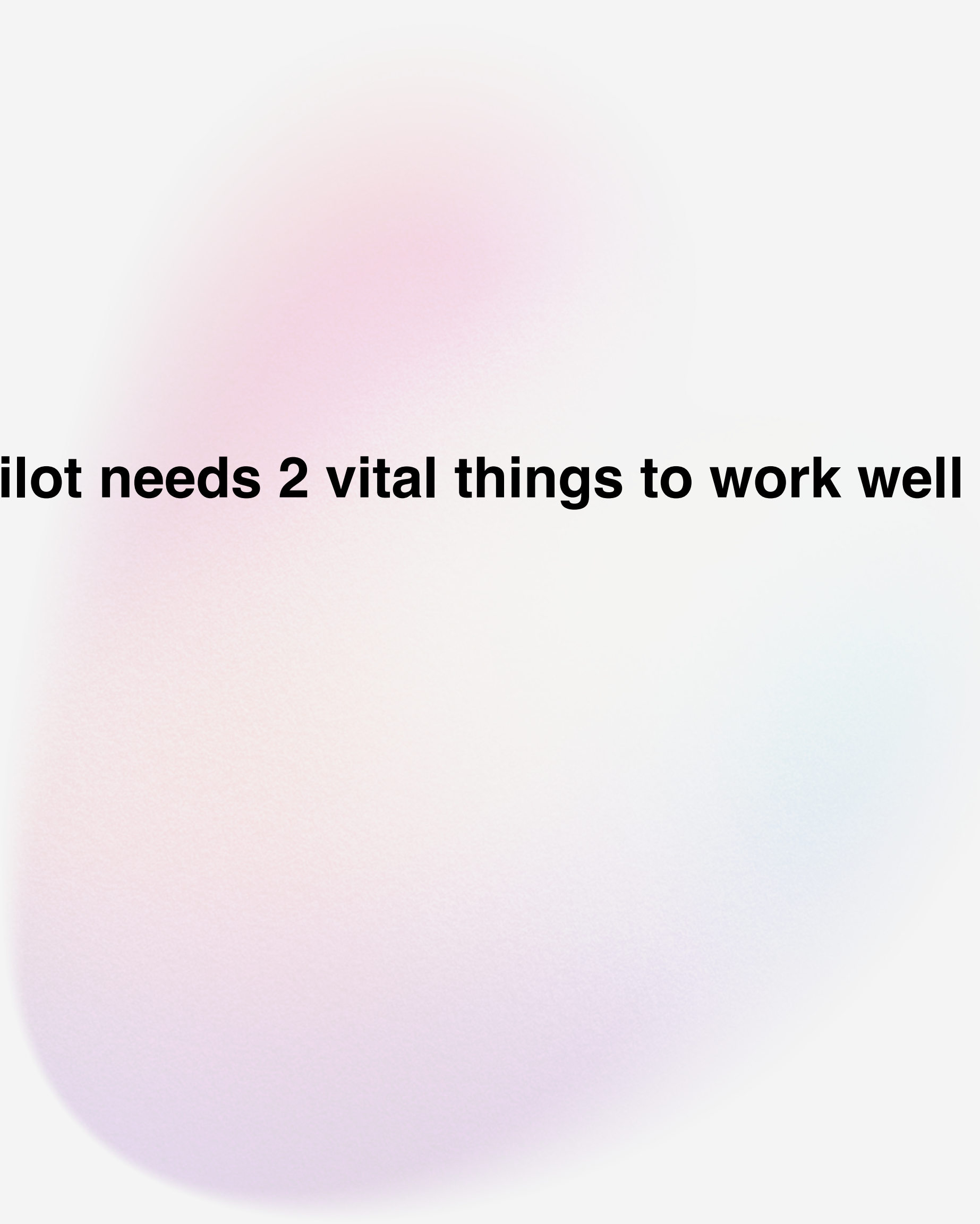
But it will absolutely guess.



So lets have a look at it

In groups:

Ask your AI a work related question something with substance. Discuss the result.



Copilot needs 2 vital things to work well

To know who you are and what you need

To be given a clear framework in which to answer



Getting to know you

Get into pairs

Lets get COSY...

Enter and complete the following in a new chat window

‘This is my persona. Please answer the following query with this in reference:

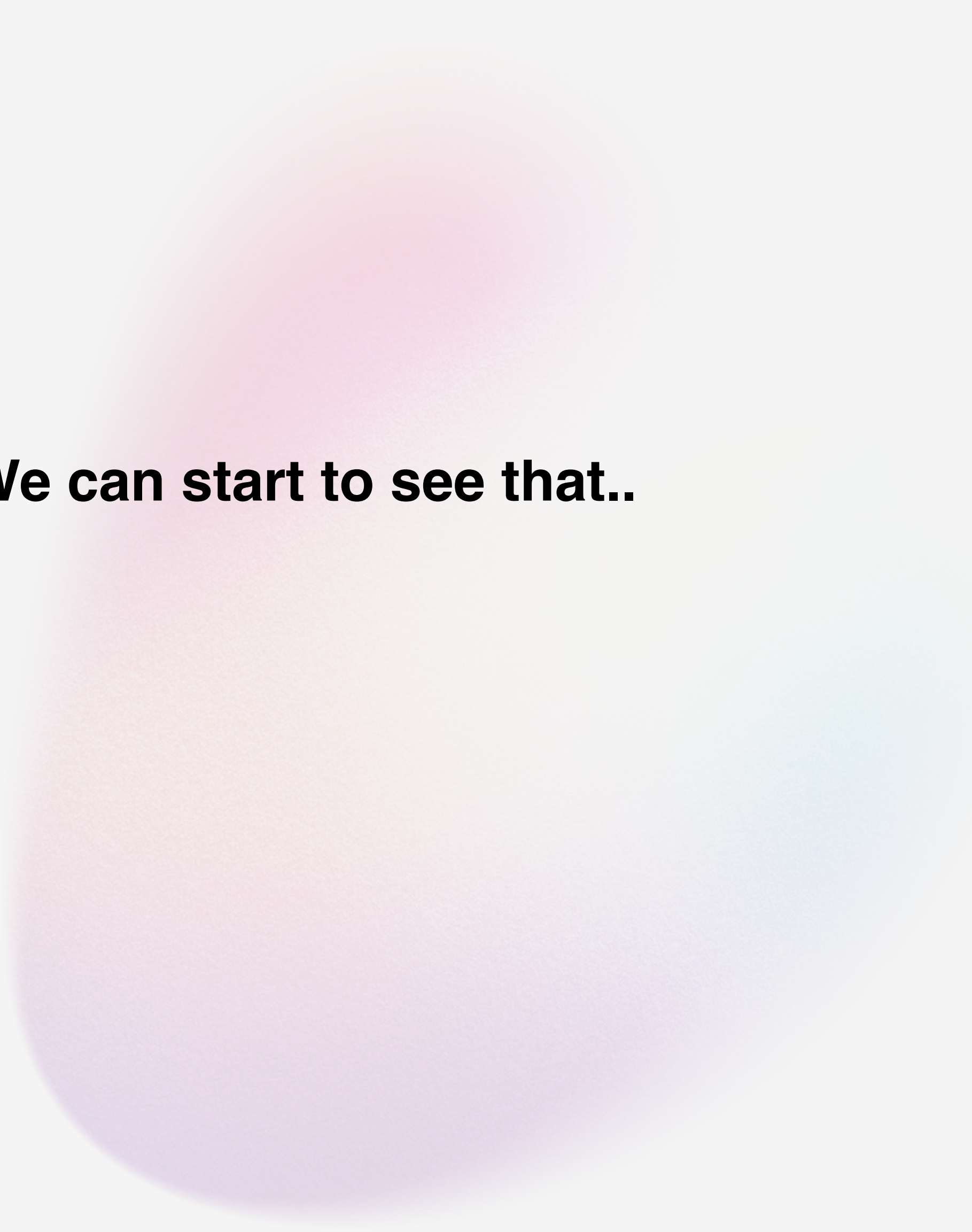
C Character - What’s your role?, What do you usually do?

O Outcomes - What does a great output look like for you?

S Style - How do you like things written? (formal, punchy, friendly...)

Y Yardsticks - What must the AI always / never do?’

Now repeat your query



We can start to see that..

AI doesn't reward intelligence.

It rewards clarity.

AI uses layers



Layer 1

COSY

- Who we are
- How we write
- What good looks like

But now we need to give it
a task...

Lets be **BRIEF**

AI needs a **BRIEF** - every *significant*
time

Create a BRIEF

Lets be BRIEF

B - Background, what's happening,
what's the context

R - Role, who should the AI act as

I - Intent, what success looks like, why
you need it

E - Examples, references, how it should
'sound' and feel, conversational,
academic, etc

F - Format, structure, length, headings,
table, checklist etc

and medical needs.

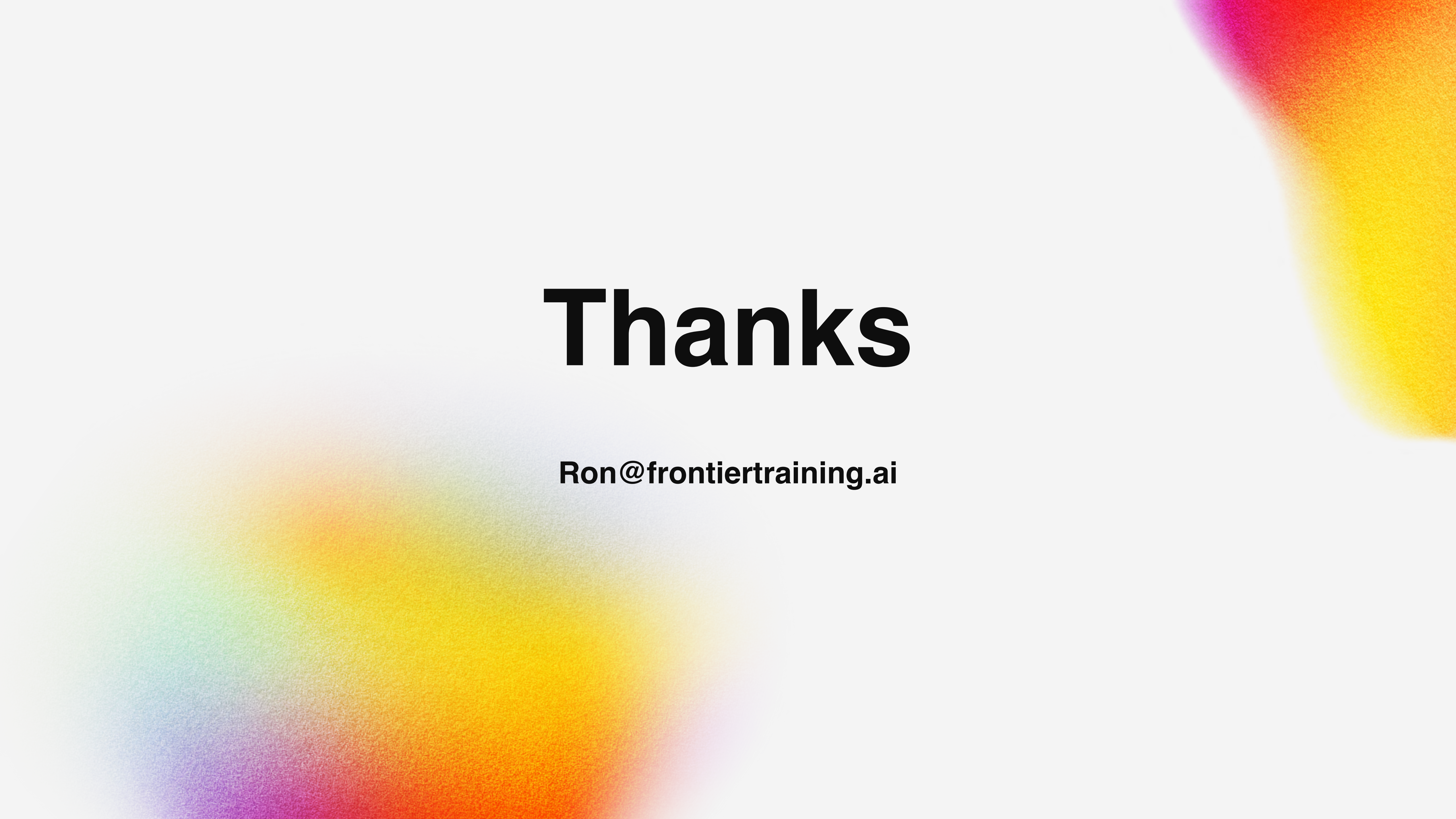
